We print below the announcement in the Catholic Standard (June 18 issue) regarding our new Pastor.

Father Thomas G. LaHood, served as pastor and earlier as parochial administrator at Our Lady's Church at Medley's Neck since 2006. While serving at Medley's Neck, he was also a chaplain at nearby St. Mary's Ryken High School in Leonardtown.

A native of Washington, he attended Good Counsel High School in Wheaton and earned a degree in history from St. Mary's College in St. Mary's City and a law degree from the University of Baltimore. He then worked as a lawyer in La Plata before entering the seminary. After studying at Theological College in Washington and the North American College in Rome, Father LaHood was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Washington in the Jubilee Year 2000. After his ordination, he served as a parochial vicar at St. Peter's Parish in Olney from 2000-04, and then for two years as a parochial vicar at St. Philip the Apostle Parish in Camp Springs.
